Out of Bounds

- 1) A ball lying on or over any road or railway fence
- 2) The compound, marked by white posts, to the right of the 1st/10th hole

Paths

All paths are to be treated as an integral part of the golf course except the path running from the front left of the 4th/13th hole to the front left of the 5th/14th hole. Interference does not exist if the path only interferes with the players stance.

Manhole Covers

All manhole covers on the course are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1

Player Safety – Shared fairway

Golfers waiting on either the 4th/13th and 5th/14th tees **MUST** give priority to golfers who are already playing the above holes. Golfers must not tee off until signaled to do so by the players ahead.

Public Safety

It is every golfers responsibility to look out for and give way to, members of the public on the golf course. Please bear in mind they may not understand where is safe, so be patient and polite at all times.
